Submitted Details Pursuant to Section 177 AE (4)(b) of the Planning & Development Act 2000, as amended Meath County Council shall make an application for approval for permission to carry out replacement work, which includes a temporary site compound and storage area at Manorlands 1st Division & Blackfriary 2nd Division, Trim, Co. Meath.

Natura Impact Statement (NIS) pursuant to Part XAB of the Planning & Development Acts 2000-2022 for the purposes of Article 6 of the Habitats Directive concluded that the proposed Trim Millenium Pedestrian Bridge Replacement Works is not foreseen to give rise to any significant adverse effects on designated European sites, alone or in combination with other plans or projects, in view of the conservation objectives of the habitats or species, for which these sites have been designated.
