The theme of the Engineer's Week Lego Competition is **Taking Flight.**

The sky's the limit for our 2025 competition.

Whether you're building fantastical flying machines, majestic birds, or futuristic spacecraft, this is your chance to *soar* to new heights.

Whatever you choose to build it must be an original creation - use of Lego kits is not allowed.

Entries will be judged under the following criteria: **Building Skill, Creativity, Theme Interpretation**.

How to Enter

- Read the terms and conditions and complete the entry form overleaf.
- Build at home using your own Lego™ bricks. Bring your build and completed entry form to one of the following libraries: Navan, Ashbourne or Trim Library. Entries will be accepted during the library's opening hours from Monday, 17th of February until Saturday, 1st of March.
- Age categories for entry are:
 - 9 to 12 years (or 3rd to 6th Class).
 - 5 to 8 (or Jnr Infants to 2nd Class).

Prizes

2 prizes will be awarded in each age category:

- Judged Entry
- Crowd favourite: Members of the public can vote for their favourite entry. Voting will take place from Monday 3rd to Saturday 8th of March*. (*Voting in Trim Library will take place on Saturday 8th March only).
- Voting slips will be available from the library desk and are strictly limited to 1 vote per person.

The winners in each category will receive a €25 voucher for Smyths Toys.

The winners will be announced on Monday, 10th of March.

Terms and Conditions

- Use your own LEGO® bricks to build an **original** creation. Constructions made from specialty themed LEGO® kits are not eligible and will be disqualified.
- Only ONE creation per person or team may be entered.
- Team projects will be placed in the category of the oldest participant in the team. <u>Each team member will require</u> their own entry form. Please note that a team will compete for a single prize.
- Your creation must fit within a space of 38 x 38 cm (1 large base plate (48x48 studs)), and be no taller than 2 ft. The size limit is not a target; small entries are just as welcome.
- By entering the competition, you are granting Meath County Council Library Service permission to use the entry for exhibition, documentation, research and publicity purposes, including library and Meath County Council approved websites and social networks.
- Lego Builds will not be considered if the terms and conditions are not accepted
- A parent or guardian must sign the entry form.
- Entries will be judged under the following criteria: Building Skill, Creativity, Theme Interpretation.
- The judges decision will be final.
- The contest entries must be collected from the library by 5pm on Friday, March 14th.
- All possible care will be taken in the handling of entries. Entrants accept that Meath County Council Library Service is not responsible for loss or damage to any entry.
- All entries must be brought to Ashbourne, Navan or Trim Library **between Monday 17**th **February and Saturday, 1**st **of March.**
